BUDGET INCREASES FOR 2011-2012

Park Tower's Board of Directors has approved the budget for the 2011-2012 year. The hard work of the management team, the Budget and Finance Committee, and the Board resulted in a minor assessment increase of 1.3%. There will also be increases in the following fees, effective March 1, 2011:

Parking: Parking rates are going up for the first time since 2008. The new rates are as shown below:

Motorcycle: raised \$3 to \$70 per month. Tandem: left unchanged at \$192 per month.

Valet: raised \$5 to \$110 per month. Self: raised \$5 to \$115 per month.

Reserved (preferred): raised \$10 to \$130 per month.

Day Parking: raised \$10 to \$129 per month.

There will be no increase in changes to guest parking fees for 2011-12, but mall merchants may no longer use their guest parking stamp. They are allowed to use parking coupons as Park Tower residents do.

Health Club: This is the first rate increase in Health Club membership fees since 2005. Starting March 1st, the new fees are:

Park Tower Residents:

Single membership: \$230/yr, \$150/6 months. Double membership: \$345/yr, \$225/6 months. Family membership: \$480/yr, \$315/6 months.

Non-residents:

Single membership: \$265/yr, \$175/6 months. Double membership: \$395/yr, \$260/6 months. Family membership: \$555/yr, \$365/6 months.

Party Room: The Party Room rental fee will now be \$100. If you are expecting more than 10 cars to be parking downstairs for your event, it may save you money if you ask the management office to provide an additional hiker in the garage for the event. This will cost \$25/hour (minimum \$100), but neither you nor your guests will have to pay any hourly parking fee or use any cou-

SMELL THAT?


What's that smell? Trash in the service vestibule is a problem that doesn't have to be. Our maintenance staff has plenty to do, and residents shouldn't create more work for them by leaving refuse on the floor. Garbage should be wrapped or bagged and pushed to fall down the chute. Cardboard and fiberboard can be recycled – break down boxes or cut them up with a box cutter and put the flattened pieces in with your paper recycling.

Only items that are too big for the chute, but small enough to be carried can be left next to the chute after 8:00 pm for removal by maintenance. Contact the office for removal of larger or heavy items –



there may be a charge. In short – you don't want to see your neighbors' trash; so remember, they don't want to see yours either.

- If there are any hazardous conditions in the unit.

WEATHER STRIPPING REPLACEMENT
