## **HOUSEKEEPING ITEMS**

#### WHAT IF I WANT TO REMODEL?

Actually, a lot of you have been asking that question. The good news is that as a community we are updating and increasing the overall value of our residences. The bad news is that there has been an increase in construction-related noise complaints. Below is a summary of remodel-ing requirements:

If you are redoing the kitchen cabinetry or replacing carpeting, you must contact the Management office so that we can let security know that the service elevators will be used. In addition, all refuse must be taken away, or you will be charged a waste fee that can be in excess of \$100.

If you are doing any major construction (i.e. new flooring, wall removal, electrical or plumbing change) you will need to come to the office to get a construction package. This package will include a contract, request for floor plans and spec requirements. This package must be received by the Management Office for our engineer's review one week prior to the Monthly Board meeting. At the Board meeting, your construction will be reviewed for approval.

**The deadline this month is August 7th**. As always, all construction must happen between 9:00 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

## THERMOSTATS

Would you like to conserve energy, lower your electric bill and feel more comfortable? Get a thermostat. The purpose of the thermostat is to better control the temperature of the room by controlling the fan. Just call the Management office and we can give you information on outside contractors that can take care of this.

#### WINDOW SHADES

All units must have gray shades. The reason why we have this rule is to avoid our building looking like a patchwork blanket. It is actually extremely important for the overall uniform look of the building. The following are some vendors that you can contact that are familiar with Park Tower:
