## COM-ED AND PARK TOWER TEAM UP TO SAVE \$ \$\$\$\$

ComEd recently met with the Lisa Volpe, Property Manager, to introduce a summertime program aimed at reducing electricity costs. Voluntary Load Reduction (VLR) is a program that offers Park Tower financial rewards for curtailing electricity during summer peak usage periods. The program is strictly voluntary and contains no penalties for non-compliance. If VLR is enacted, Park Tower will be paid \$1/kwhr for the energy it curtails during that day's period, normally between noon and 6 p.m.

ComEd has conducted a building audit and discovered several opportunities to participate which included: reducing common area and perimeter lighting, raising airconditioning temperatures, effective use of blinds, and operation of some equipment after hours.

This program is set up for a Voluntary Lead Reduction of the common areas only, and is meant for large communities, corporations and warehouses. As an individual resident, you are not eligible for the VLR however the Park Tower Condo Association is participating.

## **HOUSEKEEPING ITEMS**

#### **FILTER CHANGES**

Most of you should have your air-conditioning filters changed by now. Those who had requested that we not change your filters at the scheduled time can re-schedule beginning July 1st.

#### **YOU ARE NOT ALONE**

If you ever have the unfortunate situation of getting stuck on an elevator, know that on all the residential and passenger elevators there is an intercom system. This hooks up to the doorman's station.

#### **TO ALL YOU TREE-HUGGERS**

There are so many reasons to recycle; to save the trees, animals, air and everything else on this planet. Now here is another reason, **to save money.** Park Tower gets a rebate for all recyclables. Some people are not sure how to recycle here at Park Tower. So here is a quick how to:

- 1. Make sure you have rinsed out all cans/plastics/glass.
- 2. We have recycle bins in the laundry room, in 1P and 2P of the garage. There are 3 bins: plastics/glass, papers, cans. Dispose in appropriate bin.

#### **SMOKE DETECTORS**

For the safety of all residents, please check to see if your smoke detector is working properly. If you think there is a problem, let us know at the management office. AT NO COST TO YOU, we will check it for you and replace the batteries. If you need a new smoke detector, we will provide a new one for just \$8.00 and installation is free.

#### NEWS FROM DOWNUNDER

To all Park Tower residents using the garage,

Here are a few friendly reminders:

- There are size restrictions on vehicles allowed to park in the garage. If you plan to purchase an SUV, vans or pickup check the dimensions with the size limitations. Oversized vehicles are not permitted.
- Please throw trash only in trash receptacles, not the recycling bins.
- Please use your blue security cards to exit the garage. The hikers have been instructed only to open it in an emergency.

#### **SOAPY SUDS AND SUCH:**

Many residents have expressed that they are **very** happy with our spiffy new, clean laundry room. Most residents love the new, efficient smart card system that alleviates the need for lugging change around. We expect the system to run smoothly, but nothing is fool-proof. To be prepared for trouble spots, we have set up the following procedures.

If a washer or dryer breaks down and you lose money, come to the Management office and we can give you coupon credits. If it is after hours, write us a note and leave it at the doorman's station.

**If the Smart Card machine (VTM) goes down,** go to the front desk. The doorman can let you sign out for an emergency card that has \$5.00 credit on it. When you finish using the card, return it to doorman and deposit the money used in our lock box in the front lobby.

If your card is damaged but still has money on the card, you can return to the Management office. We will return your defective card and Universal Laundries will transfer the amount of money on your card onto your new card.

If you lose your Smart Card you can purchase a new one for \$5.00 in the VTM machine. The Management office cannot replace a lost card.
