ASCO Report to Park Tower Board, May 2022

Shape the future of Broadway: Community Planning

The last of 3 meetings focusing on the future of the Broadway corridor in the 48th Ward will take place at the Broadway Armory on Saturday May 21 from 10-noon.

All area residents are invited to participate.

Suggestions from the previous two meetings: places for people to sit, more walking space and trees, more parking, bike lanes, improvements to pedestrian crosswalks and mixed use housing.

Alderman Osterman surprised everyone at the last meeting, on April 30, by saying that he would like to have a swimming pool constructed north of the Broadway Armory at the SE corner of Broadway & Thorndale where, currently, there is a parking lot.

From the Office of 48th Ward Alderman Harry Osterman:

On Monday afternoon, May 2, the body of a woman was recovered from Lake Michigan by Foster Beach. The details of her drowning death are currently being investigated.

Last week in the Belle Shore Apartments @ 1062 Bryn Mawr police found the body of a female college student who was shot and killed in the building. As police were investigating, they found the body of a male resident who is believed to have died due to a self-inflicted gunshot. Chicago Police are investigating and believe these deaths to be a possible murder-suicide.

At 6pm **this evening**, at the Edgewater Presbyterian Church 1020 W. Bryn Mawr, Alderman Osterman held a Town Hall safety meeting with Commander Brendan McCrudden, 20th Police District, to discuss community safety issues in the area east of Broadway from Hollywood to Foster.

Beat community meetings are a key part of the CAPS strategy of partnerships and problem solving.
