## **Election Day, February 28th**

### **48<sup>th</sup> Ward Aldermanic Candidates**

Also on the ballot on February 28<sup>th</sup> voters of each police district will be electing 3 members to the newly created Police District Councils.

District Councils in each Police District will:

- be made up of 3 paid officials elected every 4 years
- serve as a bridge between the Community & the Police
- hold monthly public meetings, where residents can work with the police on local community concerns and give input on police policies and practices
