

ASSESSMENT PAYMENT COUPONS

Please be advised that payment coupon books will be mailed in late February. These payment books will reflect the increases in assessments for the new fiscal year. Until they are received you will be responsible for sending your assessment payments in before the 10th of the month. Invoices for February's assessment payment will be mailed in late January. If you need assistance on your payment amounts - or do not receive your payment book please contact the Park Tower Management Office at 769-3250.

MAINTENANCE CORNER - (CLOGGED DRAINS)

To keep your drains clear, make sure the strainer is kept in the tub when you shower or bathe. Clean out the strainer on a regular basis. Should the drain become clogged despite your best efforts **DO NOT** use commercial drain cleaners (these chemicals cause damage to the pipes). Instead call the management office to have the drain rodded out at no charge.

CURTAIN WALL REPAIR UPDATE

Due to the cold weather conditions, the outside Curtain Wall repairs have been put on hold. To date we have completed the first drop of the 06 tier. (There are two drops to the 06 tier). Testing of the completed portion of this tier has proven to be promising, however, the true test will be the spring, when weather conditions produce heavy rains with strong winds. Those of you living in the 06 tier should keep us advised of any water leakage, no matter how small, so that we can monitor the effectiveness of current work being done. **REMEMBER, THIS TIER IS A TEST TIER !**

The outside fix that is currently being done will hopefully prevent most of the water infiltration caused by rain and high winds. It will not take care of all of our water leakage problems. One problem that the current fix does not address is water infiltration from condensation on the windows. We need your help to prevent water damage to your apartment as well as your neighbors below you. Turning your humidifier off or on a low setting will reduce the amount of ice formation on your windows. If you find that you have ice forming on your windows, place towels on your window sills. As the outside temperature rises, the ice on your windows will begin to melt. The towels will absorb most of this water. After determining that this outside fix is effective, we will proceed with the next tier.

GIVE MANAGEMENT ANY NECESSARY PHONE NUMBERS

To give residents and absentee owners the best possible service, the management office needs to have home and business phone numbers. In the event of an emergency, it could be very extremely important to have this information. Please contact the management office as soon as possible with this information.
